- Childcare for young children at most colleges.
- Food pantries at each college with free, healthy food.
- Tutoring services to help you do well in class.
- Access to the Wellness Center for counseling and other mental health services.

## To take free classes to prepare for your high school diploma, you must:

- ✓ Live in Illinois.
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old.
  - 16 and 17-year-old students may register with an official release letter certifying they are no longer attending high school.
- ✗ Students do **not** need to have a Social Security number or be a United States citizen to enroll.
- ✗ Students with F1, F2, J1, or J2 visas are **not** eligible to enroll.
- ✗ Short-term visitors to the United States are **not** able to enroll.



## Class Options

Free classes are available at all skill levels. You can prepare for your high school diploma in person, online, during the day, at night, and even on weekends.
