

Pre- and Post-testing

When students start any Adult Education program at City Colleges, they take a pre-test (CASAS and TABE) that places them into the appropriate course level. After a minimum of 40 hours of instruction, they take a post-test to assess their progress. ICCB's standard is that 65% of all students take this post-test. In FY23, City Colleges exceeded that goal, with 66% of Adult Ed students taking the post-test (as of June 5, 2023).

Level Gains

This metric shows how students are progressing on their state mandated pre and post-test assessments.

CCC is collectively at a **32% Level Gain** rate compared to ICCB's goal of **37%** (as of June 5, 2023).

Student Enrollment by Program*







OUR EDUCATORS



- 72 City Colleges Adult Education administrators and educators have:
 - Created and hosted nearly 600 individual in-house professional development sessions
 - Collaborated to create effective curriculum
- City Colleges funds the baseline 12 hours of professional development requirement for the state of Illinois for all our adult educators. In FY23, 85% of adult educators completed the requirement.
- Additionally, 100 adult educators have completed the Standards Proficient Instructor Training.



COMMUNITY IMPACT

The impact that Adult Education has on our communities is multifaceted. Higher earning potential throughout a high school diploma earner's lifetime is just the beginning – healthcare costs, family literacy, and incarceration rates are all directly impacted by adult literacy skills. When adults improve their education, our communities are uplifted, and the confidence and feelings of inclusion of adult learners are immeasurable.

Savings:
